



Bunk House Information Sheet

Our accommodation consists of one large accommodation block on a grassed area behind the parachute centre. Inside there are 11 basic dormitory style rooms with bunkbeds and shared shower and toilet facilities. 6 ensuite rooms (4 of which are premium ones with their own private door)

1. Bed in a shared dormitory room £9 per bed per night. Bedding and towels not provided.
2. Basic private room – can sleep up to 4 people in 2 bunkbeds. Some rooms are available with one double bed and one bunkbed. £26 per room per night. Bedding and towels not provided.
3. Ensuite room with double or twin beds (sleeps 2) £38 per room per night. Bedding and towels provided.
4. Premium ensuite room £42 per room per night. Cable television included in room. Comfortable, deluxe bed and bedding and towels provided. Option of double or twin beds, subject to availability. Room A is an accessible room with ramp access and wet room.

We do also have a large grassy area for camping and 8 electric hook up points (£5 per night charge to use electric hook up)

Our main bunkhouse offers basic no-frills accommodation for regular sports jumpers and skydiving students. Rooms are kept clean and tidy but consist of beds only. Whilst we welcome tandem customers, please note that if you are looking for more comfortable lodgings then a local hotel or guesthouse might be more suitable.

Making a reservation All rooms must be prepaid in full. An additional £20 key deposit is payable which will be refunded to you upon return of your key on departure.

Check In & Check Out Check in from 3pm onwards Check out by Midday. Late check out will incur a fee of £20 Failure to return your key will result in the loss of your key deposit

Cancellations & changes Your reservation may be changed to an alternative date with at least 48 hours notice. Cancellations made with less than 48 hours notice from 2pm on the day of arrival will be charged in full – no refund will be available.

On rare occasions it may be necessary for us to cancel your reservation. In this situation any monies will be refunded to you, however we cannot accept any liability from you for anything arising from our cancellation.

Refunds Reservations cancelled with less than 48 hours notice cannot be refunded. Any refunds can only be made to the cardholder who made the reservation.

Children Anyone aged under 16 must be accompanied by an adult overnight. Children are not permitted to sleep on the top bunk for their own safety and must be supervised at all times whilst on the dropzone.

Further Information

Electrical supply to the airfield is limited, therefore we ask that you do not bring electric kettles, hairdryers and other high voltage electrical items as they can trip the supply. The charging of phones, camera equipment and DVD players is permitted. Please report any damage to reception or a member of staff. Please leave your room in a clean and tidy condition.

Personal and valuable possessions are left entirely at your own risk. Skydive Hibaldstow cannot take any responsibility for any items left unattended.

We remind all customers that on busy weekends in particular that the bunkhouse can become very noisy, and ask that you are quiet and considerate when others may be sleeping. Abusive or aggressive behaviour towards other customers or staff will not be tolerated.

Dogs and other animals/pets are not permitted on the dropzone under any circumstances (except guidedogs) so please leave them at home.

Safety

The Fire meeting point is located on the main grass area. Smoking is strictly prohibited in and around the bunkhouse. Please ensure all doors are closed in the building – they are fire doors and are not effective if left open. For the same reason please do not prop doors open. Open fires and BBQs are not permitted on the airfield. All names of persons staying in each room must be provided.

Café facilities

It is advisable if you are arriving late at night to have your evening meal before you set off as there are no catering facilities onsite and it is likely other than in peak Summer periods that our café will be closed. Restaurants and takeaways can be found in the nearby town of Brigg. Breakfast is available every morning when the airfield is open.

Car parking

Parking is available free of charge in the main Skydive Hibaldstow car park located behind the large green aircraft hangar. Please do not park on the farmland or roads leading to the dropzone. A map is available in the car park.

Disabled access A disabled drop-off area is located near to the main clubhouse reception. We have an ensuite room with disabled access and toilet/shower facilities. The main clubhouse has disabled access and disabled toilets inside. If you require any special assistance please contact us in advance and we will do our best to help.

Reception is open 8-5pm Wednesday-Sunday so if you will be arriving outside these hours, please let staff know at time of booking and we will leave the key in the room for you.
